Pet Toys:

- * Gently used colorful t-shirts (not white)

Hygiene Kit Items:

- * Hand Towels (15 x 25 inches to 17 x 27 inches; Kitchen, cleaning, and microfiber towels not acceptable)
- * Washcloths (for face)
- * Combs (need to be sturdy and longer than 6 inches; no pocket combs or picks please) Rattail combs and combs without handles are acceptable with a minimum of 6 inches of teeth
- * Metal nail file or nail clippers (No emery boards, please)
- * Bath-sized soaps (3 oz. and larger sizes only; no Ivory or Jergens soap due to moisture content; do not remove from original packaging)
- * Toothbrushes (Adult size only, do not remove from original packaging)
- * Adhesive bandages (common household Band-Aids; ¾ inch to 1 inch-size)
- * One-gallon sized sealable plastic bag
- * \$1.00 to purchase toothpaste



Birthday bag items:

- * Cake Mix
- * Birthday cards
- * Birthday plates
- * Candles
- * little party favors
- * bigger gift bags to put the items into for the family
- * Small gifts like Legos, building sets, craft kits, science kits, puzzles, sports balls, etc.
- * Cake frosting
- * Napkins
- * Cups
- * Wrapping paper
